- Students in the Communication major are required to demonstrate proficiency in one foreign language equivalent to the 121 course through course credit or the corresponding foreign language placement score.
- 5. Communication Skills Courses (6 hours): COMM 201, 202, 203, 204.
- 6. Communication Major Electives (15 hours):
  - a. Six hours at 300-level and above.
  - b. Six hours at 400-level and above.
  - c. Three hours at 500-level.

- All undergraduate students must take a 3-credit course or its equivalent with a passing grade that covers the founding documents. This course may
  fulfill any requirement in the program of study. Courses that meet this requirement are listed in the academic bulletin.
