- 1. This program is designed to be completed in 20 months.

This program will cost \$25,798.75 for residents and \$42,598.75 for non-residents choosing the concentration in Adult Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner, \$28,566.25 for residents and \$46,710.25 for non-residents choosing the concentration in Family Nurse Practitioner, and \$27,516.25 for residents and \$45,660.25 for non-residents choosing the concentration in Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner, if the program is completed within normal time. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed. Students who already hold a certification in Advanced Practice Registered Nursing may be able to complete the program in less time or have lower costs. Each applicant will be assessed individually.
